INTRODUCTION

The City of Sports Camilo Cano is a modern sports complex, which has become a reference point at both national and international levels. Over the whole year, important sports events are organized in these facilities, attracting thousands of visitors from all over the world to the town of La Nucía. A lot of sportsmen and women have trained in the facilities of La Nucía City of Sports (more than 80 sports facilities spread over an area of 150,000 m²), where you can practise a great variety of sports -more than one hundred- : water, adventure, motor, team, strength, wrestling, ball, mountain, shooting and board sports.

La Nucía residents can enjoy warm weather during the whole year, with an average temperature of 18° C in winter and 27 ° C in summer and with high levels of solar radiation (2,413 sun hours per year).

HOW TO ARRIVE

La Nucía is a town in the Valencian Community, located 8 km North from Benidorm and about 45 km away from the main city, Alicante.

By road:

You can use the Mediterranean Coast Motorway AP-7, which connects our town with Valencia, Alicante and the trunk roads of Madrid, Murcia and Andalucía, taking the exit nº 65. There are three main exits to La Nucía: Terra Mítica, Benidorm and Altea. The National Road N-332 is the parallel axis to the Valencia Coast, which communicates La Nucía with Alicante and Valencia, taking afterwards the CV 70 (Benidorm - Callosa D' en Sarriá).

By plane:

There are 3 airports near the town:

- The Altet Airport, very near Alicante, is located 51 km away from La Nucía. It connects main European and National cities.
- The Airport of Manises, in Valencia, is approximately 140 km away from La Nucía. From there you can travel to the most important cities in Spain and in the rest of Europe..
- You can also use the airport of San Javier, Murcia, 146 km away from our town.

By train:

There is a train connection with Alicante by Talgo Train Units and AVE (a high Speed Rail). And there is also a narrow-gauge railway service from Alicante to Benidorm where you can connect with La Nucía by bus or taxi.



AWARDS

The town has experienced significant growth over the last few years, especially in some particular fields, such as the field of Sports. Proof of this, is the prestigious title recently awarded to our town, the **National Prize of Sport 2012**, by the Superior Sports Council -a ceremony presided by the King and Queen of Spain-. This award recognizes the great job done by La Nucía Town Hall in the year 2012 in the promotion of sport: many important events have been organized and excellent sport facilities have been built.

La Nucía has joined a select number of Spanish cities who have received both the National Prize of Sport and the title of European Cities of Sport in the European Parliament in Brussels by the federation for the Associations of the European Capitals and Cities of Sport (ACES) among 27 countries in the European Union thanks to "its excellent facilities, management systems and promotion of a healthy lifestyle among its citizens".

In addition to these awards, the Artificial Grass Football 11 Pitch has obtained the best quality certificate that can be given to a field of these particular characteristics, **FIFA two stars (Field Certificate)**. Only three artificial grass fields in Spain have got this certificate. To obtain it, the artificial grass fields "Vicente del Bosque" in the City of Sports Camilo Cano from La Nucía, had to go through a quality assessment made by the **Biomechanical Institute of the Polytechnic University of Valencia**.

The **FIFA two star (Field Certificate)** is the highest quality certificate that can be given to a football field with artificial turf.

There are only 3 artificial pitches in Spain that have this maximum qualification of FIFA (two stars). In order to receive it, the artificial turf pitches **“Vicente del Bosque”** in Camilo Cano Sports City passed a quality control test conducted by the **Institute of Biomechanics of the Polytechnic University of Valencia.**

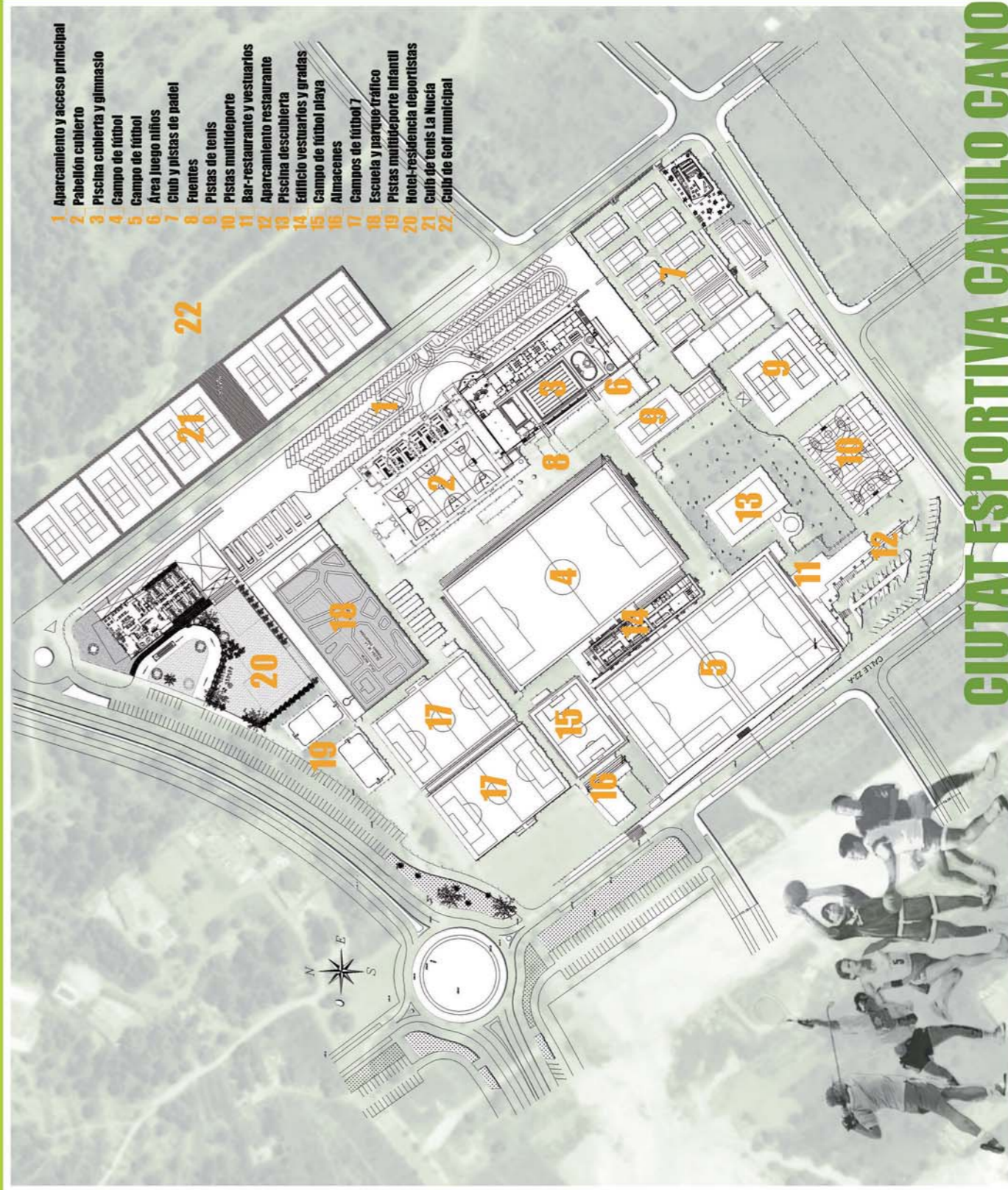


GENERAL VIEW MAP OF SURFACES

EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES



35TH NATIONAL GALA OF THE SPANISH SPORTS PRESS ASSOCIATION

On March 2nd, 2015, the Spanish Sports Press Association paid tribute to several sportsmen and women and to some sporting institutions, which achieved great success at both national and international levels throughout the year 2014. The ceremony took place in the City of Sports Camilo Cano and the honorees were the following: **Mireia Belmonte** (World and European Swimming Champion), **Ona Carbonell** (European Synchronized Swimming Sub-champion), **Laia Sanz** (World Motorcycling Champion Enduro), **Alejandro Valverde** (number one of UCI), and **Real Madrid and Atlético de Madrid Football Clubs**. This Gala was broadcast live by TVE through Teledeporte.

During the show, the professional career of Doctor Pedro Guillen was recognized and he was awarded a Prize in Sports Medicine. **Juan Manuel Asensi**, ex-football player for Barcelona and for the Spanish Team, was awarded the Legend Prize.

Almost at the end of the event, a particular tribute was rendered to **Alfredo di Stéfano**, deceased in 2014, with a video of the

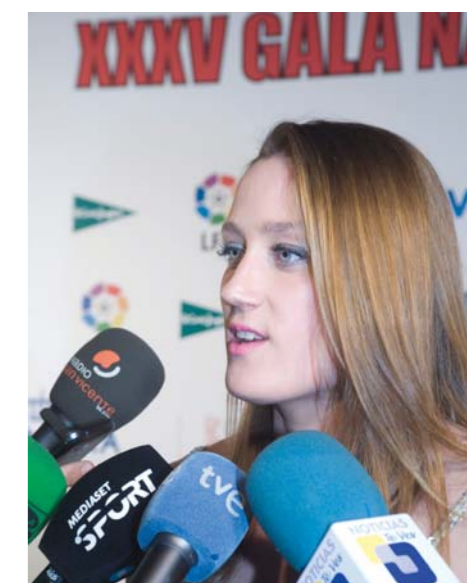

legendary player of Real Madrid, which received a great ovation from the audience. The most important sportsmen / women were the swimmers **Mireia Belmonte** and **Ona Carbonell**, the pilot **Tito Rabat**, the president of Atlético de Madrid **Enrique Cerezo** and **Emilio Butragueño**.

More than 2,000 people followed live this Gala at Camilo Cano Sports Hall. Apart from the winning sportsmen and women, leading figures in the world of sports and politics were present and more than 200 journalists from the most important Spanish sports newspapers (**As, Marca, Sport, Mundo Deportivo, Súperdeporte**...etc) covered the event.

It was the most important event at national level celebrated in La Nucía, after the awards of the National Prize of Sport and the European City of Sports. This Gala has been possible thanks to the clear commitment for the Sport of La Nucía Town Hall.

ENGLAND NATIONAL FOOTBALL TEAM

In the month of November 2015, the England National Football Team chose the City of Sports Camilo Cano to train for a friendly match against Spain which was going to be held on Nov., 13th in the Stadium Rico Perez, in Alicante.

Several training sessions of different top-level football teams, such as **Utrecht** from the Dutch Eredivisie, **Spartak** from Moscow or the **Shakhtar Donetsk** from Ukraine had been carried out in these facilities. And national teams of lower categories such as the Spanish Under-17 Team or the Mexican and North American under-16 teams have also trained

in the City of Sports Camilo Cano. But never a National Team of the level of the UK.

During three days, the team of Roy Hodgson carried out trainings sessions behind closed doors in the natural grass pitches of the City of Sports.

Manchester United striker **Wayne Rooney**, top goal scorer of the "pross", Chelsea centre-back **Gary Cahill**; as well as some young players: **Sterling** from Manchester City, and Tottenham striker **Harry Kane** were some of the most important players who enjoyed the mini-stage in these facilities.



INAUGURATION OF VICENTE DEL BOSQUE FOOTBALL PITCHES

The manager of the Spanish National Football Team visited La Nucía on the 23rd of January to inaugurate the remodelling of the artificial grass football pitches. Since that date, these pitches are called "Campos de Fútbol de Vicente del Bosque".

More than 3,000 people came to the City of Sports on that day to pay tribute to the manager of the Spanish National Football Team.

26 Base Football Teams and the 350 players of the Base Indoor Football team took part in this event and were photographed with Vicente del Bosque.

The whole event was organized by La Nucía Town Hall in collaboration with the Football Federation of the Valencian Community and the Royal Spanish Football Federation.

It was an excellent opportunity to pay tribute to Vicente del Bosque, manager of the Spanish National Football Team. Thanks to his great job, the Spanish Football Team won the World Cup in South Africa in 2010 and the 2012 European Football Championship.



WORLD PADDEL TENNIS TOUR

The best Paddle Tennis Tournament visited La Nucía – “European City of Sports” and “National Prize of Sport”- for the third year running. A central court was especially built for this sports event inside the Camilo Cano Sports Hall. 2,200 people could follow live all the matches of the World TOP 10 Paddle Tennis pairs during the week from the 17th to the 23rd of August. It is the stage nº8 of the 16 stages which make up the World Paddle Tour.

The best Paddle Tennis players in the world, both in men and women’s categories, took part in this Open Estrella Damm La Nucía. In men’s category, the nº1 pair in the world formed by **Fernando Belasteguín** and **Pablo Lima** won the final match of the World Paddle Tour “Estrella Dam La Nucía Open”; “the Invincible ones” won in a legendary match in 2 sets, 7-6 / 7-6 , against the pair formed by **Juan Marín Díaz- Maxi Sánchez**.

In the international women’s circuit the pair formed by **Mapi and Majo Sánchez Alayeto** won a very hard-fought final match against **Eli Amatriain and Paty Llaguno**. Throughout the week, approximately 20,000 people followed live all the matches in the facilities of the City of Sports and in streaming on the web site www.worldpadeltour.com.

HIKING AND ORIENTEERING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

BASE FOOTBALL REGIONAL GALA

Season 2013-2014

For the fourth consecutive year, the Provincial Delegation of the Valencian Community Federation, chose the Camilo Cano Sports Hall as the venue for the Gala Awards Ceremony corresponding to the Season 2013-2014.

A total of 147 teams received their awards: champion and sub-champion in 16 categories of Football, Women's Football and Base Indoor Football. Among them, there were **five teams from La Nucía Football Club** which won three championships and two sub-championships last season: **La Nucía "B" (Youngest Category)** was champion of the 3rd Group trained by Denis Groynefue and **La Nucía "A" Juvenile** was the winner of the 4th Group Juveniles of Football 8 of the Province of Alicante, trained by Paco Sánchez. The third champion team from La Nucía was **La Nucía FC Cadets** Category which was the first of the 2nd Group of Second Cadet Category last season, trained by Agim Xhafa. Moreover, **La Nucía "A" (Youngest Category)**, trained by "Pepito" Fuster was sub-champion of the 4th Group and the **Juvenile "B"** was second of the 3rd Group, trained by Luis Cloquell.

Jus before the beginning of the Gala, the trophies of the 2010 World Championship of South Africa and 2012 Football Eurocup, won by "La Roja", were exhibited in the Camilo Cano Sports Hall.



3rd NATIONAL PADBOL CHAMPIONSHIP

For the third year running, the City of Sports Camilo Cano in La Nucía was the venue for the 3rd National Padball Championship, held between 3rd and 6th September. As a new feature, this year there were women's categories. During four intense days, 100 players from 16 different clubs battled to get the national "crown" of Padball 2015.

La Nave del Padbol from Palma de Mallorca in men's category and Sport Padbol from Elche in women's category were the winners of this third edition, which

The 4th Edition of La Nucia Sport Xperience (LNSX), a top-level sports festival recognized both in Spain and abroad, took place during Easter Holidays.

A great number of people, among participants and visitors, enjoyed watching or practising more than 70 sports activities during 72 hours sport-non-Stop for all ages. The main aim of this festival, which usually lasts three days, is to promote the practice of sports.

5 GREAT AREAS

The 4th Edition of La Nucia Sport Xperience took place in the City of Sports Camilo Cano and the space was divided into 5 great areas for: tournaments, sport activities, exhibitions, collective lessons and recreational activities. Only two of these areas were not free: the ones used for tournaments and collective

lessons. The rest was completely free.

This year, fantastic bouncy castles were set up, painting workshops were organized and there was also a fairground. In the children's play-centre, other recreational activities such as storytellers took place and all the children had a great time.

VENUE FOR THE 22ND COSTABLANCA CUP

The 22nd Edition of Costa Blanca Cup, an International Football and Indoor Football Tournament organized by Tour Sport, took place in the towns of La Nucia, Altea, Benidorm, Calpe, Benissa and La Vila Joiosa, from July 6th to July 11th.

For the 4th consecutive time, La Nucia was the venue for the final matches and handing over of trophies on the 10th and 11th of July, due to its excellent sports facilities. Our town allowed the use of two Football 11 and two Football 8 Pitches with artificial grass. **103 matches from the Costa Blanca Cup were played in these pitches from the 6th to the 11th of July.** La Nucia has become the main organizer of the Costa Blanca Cup since the most important events of the Cup - the final matches and the handing over of trophies - have been held here. Admission is free for all matches of this "Mini World Cup of Base Football"

In this edition, the number of participant countries was 20 and there were 239 teams (33 more than in the last edition). A total of 567 matches were played with the participation of 4,000 players. The Costa Blanca Cup in 2015 had teams coming from different continents: Russia, France, United Kingdom, Portugal, Norway, Brazil, Colombia, The United States, Canada, Dominican Republic, India, China etc...

It is, without any doubt, an important event to promote football and active sports tourism. It has achieved



great consideration due to its international nature and to the promotion of social interaction among young people coming from different countries.

On the 5th of December, the 9th Edition of the Off Road Crossing Maroc Challenge -an African race for amateur teams- started from La Nucía towards Morocco. This is the second time that our town becomes the starting point for a race through Moroccan lands. 93 amateur teams from all over Europe took part in it: Spain, Portugal, Italy, Great Britain, Ukraine, Romania, Finland... and even a team from the United States of America. From the City of Sports Camilo Cano, the Caravan drove to Motril and from that point to the African Continent. Once there, the participants went to Nador and

later to Ifrane, Midelt, Erfoud and Merzouga where the stage finished on December, 11th. Teams can take part in this non-profit race either with private cars or with off-road vehicles. The only condition is for them to be registered before 1999. It is a 2,000 km race through tracks, deserts and Moroccan roads. Among the participant teams there were 3 from La Nucía, 2 of them drove 2 Renault 4 cars and the other one a Jeep Cherokee. First class "Dakar" pilots such as Eric González (trucks) and the legendary Phillip Ligue took part in this 9th Edition.



PROVINCIAL DAY OF ADAPTED SPORTS

In 2015 and for the sixth year running, 389 students accompanied by monitors, teachers, and volunteers -741 people altogether- enjoyed the facilities of the City of Sports in La Nucía. 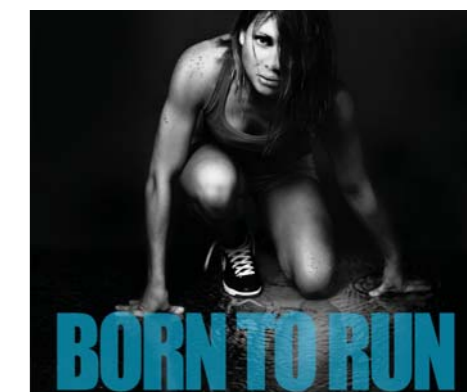

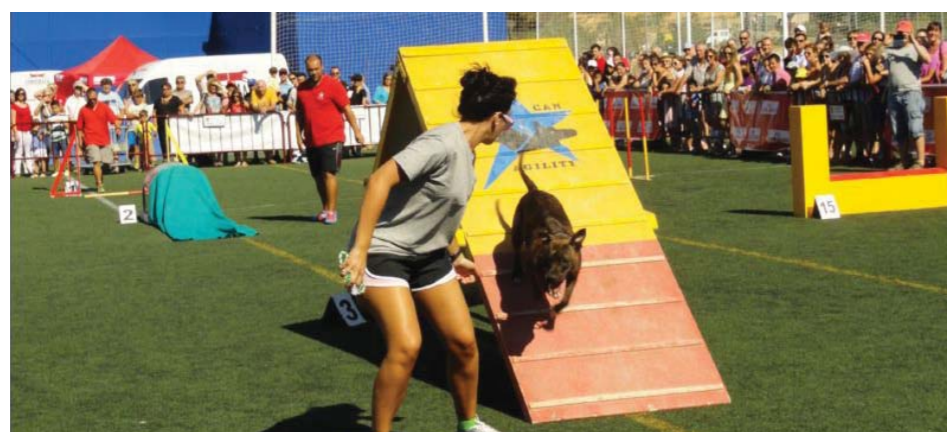

On January 16, it took place at the headquarters of the Spanish Olympic Committee (COE) in Madrid the signing of the agreement between the municipality of La Nucía and Olympic organisms through the establishment of a new Centre for Olympic Studies in La Nucía. A new step for the consolidation of La Nucía as "City of Sport" and to promote "sport and the Olympic spirit in the municipality". This is the thirty-second Olympic Studies Centre created by the Spanish Olympic Committee and the third agreement that is signed with a municipality.

Olympic Studies Centres have been created with the intention of extending the scope of the Spanish Olympic Academy, through conducting outreach activities of the Olympic Movement, jointly with universities and municipalities where these

Study Centers are present.

Being Olympic Studies Centre will allow to La Nucía work together and collaborate with 30 universities throughout Spain for different research projects related to sport: sports management, nutrition, promotion of sports ... etc with the aim of improving the quality of sports training to all levels and ages.

Among the aims of the Olympic Studies Centres include ensuring the acquisition, preservation and dissemination of the Olympic heritage; promote and facilitate access to written and audiovisual Olympic collections; providing research services, analysis and content creation; promote academic activities related to the Olympics; and stimulate synergies and collaboration between Olympic studies centers

and researchers. In addition, these centers seek to promote cooperation with the Olympic Movement to ensure that the overall Olympic heritage is preserved and make it available to everyone. The Olympic Studies Centre of La Nucía depends on the Spanish Olympic Academy of Spanish Olympic Committee, presiding by Alejandro Blanco.

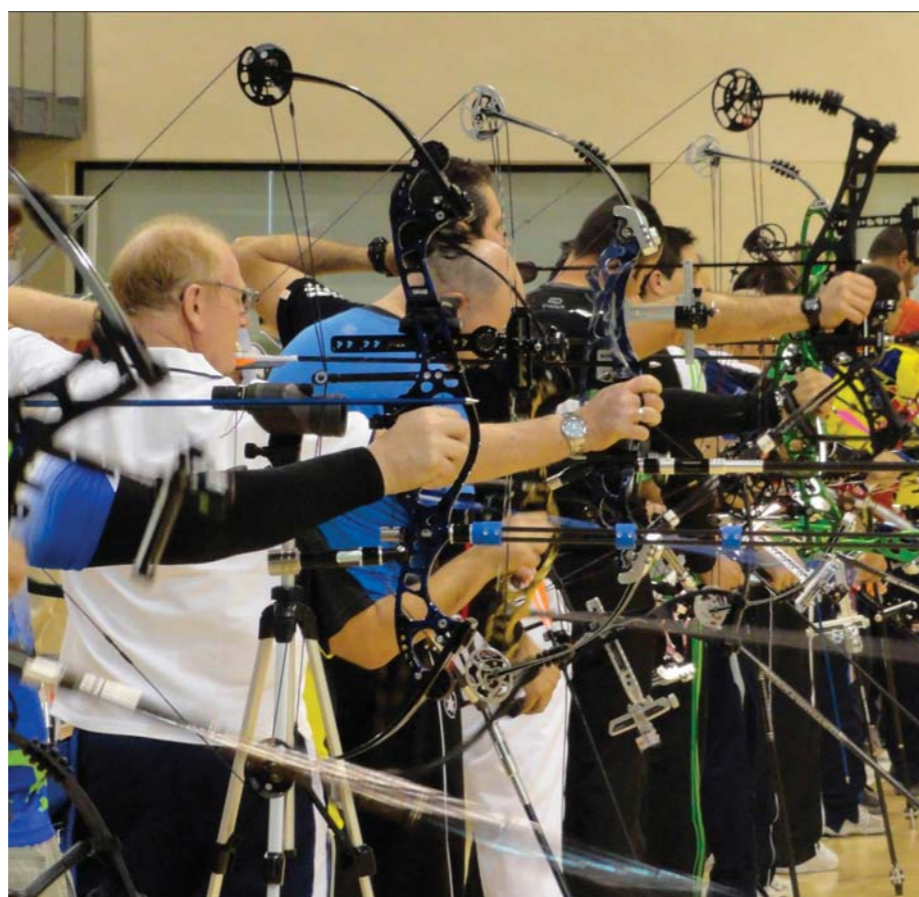

FIPA (International Federation of Padbol) designated Spain like seat to host the second World Cup in 2014, and Padbol Spain and the Spanish Padbol Association, among all possible places, selected the city of La Nucia to host this Second World Padbol for "its excellent facilities, environment and experience in sports events management".

The Sports City Camilo Cano has two permanent Padbol tracks since June 2013 and for this World Cup, in addition of the two outdoor tracks, a central panoramic track of Padbol was installed in the Pavilion Municipal

Camilo Cano La Nucia. The World Championship developed during four days (from 20 to 23 November) attended by 30 players from seven countries (Argentina, Mexico, Uruguay, Sweden, Italy, Portugal and Spain).

Spanish dominance in this 2nd World Padbol championship held in La Nucia was overwhelming so the three spanish pairs took a clean sweep of the top three podium positions, demonstrating the high level of Spanish Padbol today.

The Spanish pair of Juan Alberto Ramon and Juanmi Hernández, are proclaimed new world champions of this sport after winning the final by 6-4, and 7-5 to also Spanish pair, Eleazar Ocaña and Toni Palacios, world champions in 2013.

The International Federation IFBB (International Bodybuilding Federation) chose La Nucia to host one of its most important annual events.

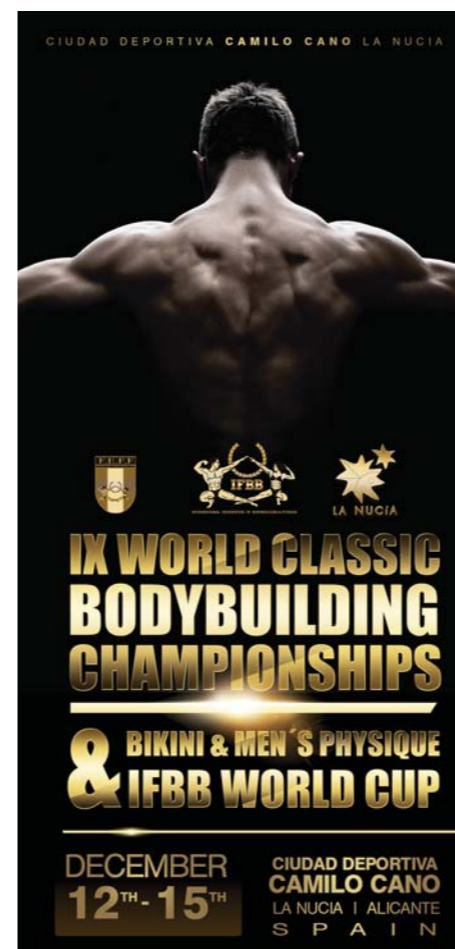

Finland, France, Germany, Latvia and Moldova competed in the Sports Pavilion of Sports City Camilo Cano La Nucia in three world competitions: IX World Championship "Classic BodyBuilding", World Cup IFBB Fitness & Bikini and World Cup IFBB Men's Physique.
